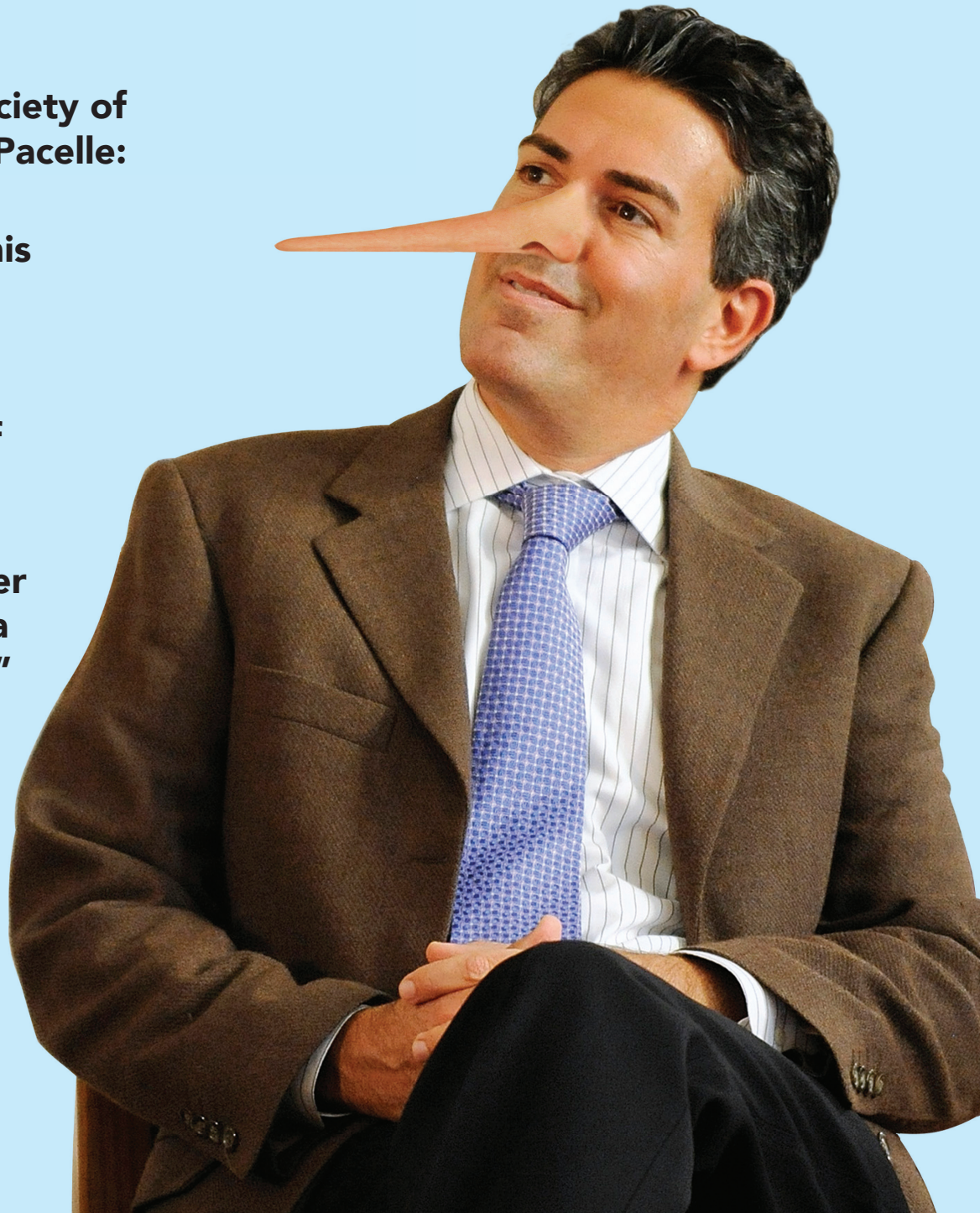


Why Should Congress Listen to Someone Who's Already Lied to Them?
